



Sawyer Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Order Form

Note: Free PPE is available only to certified Appalachian Trail sawyers with the approval of their A.T. maintaining clubs. Please allow up to a month for processing and delivery.

Sawyers should provide their own gloves and boots:

Gloves: Slip-resistant, appropriate for weather conditions; cut resistant for chain filing.

Boots: Heavy-duty, leather or cut-resistant, waterproof or water-repellent, eight-inch-high, laced boots with nonskid soles and adequate ankle support; hard toes are optional.
