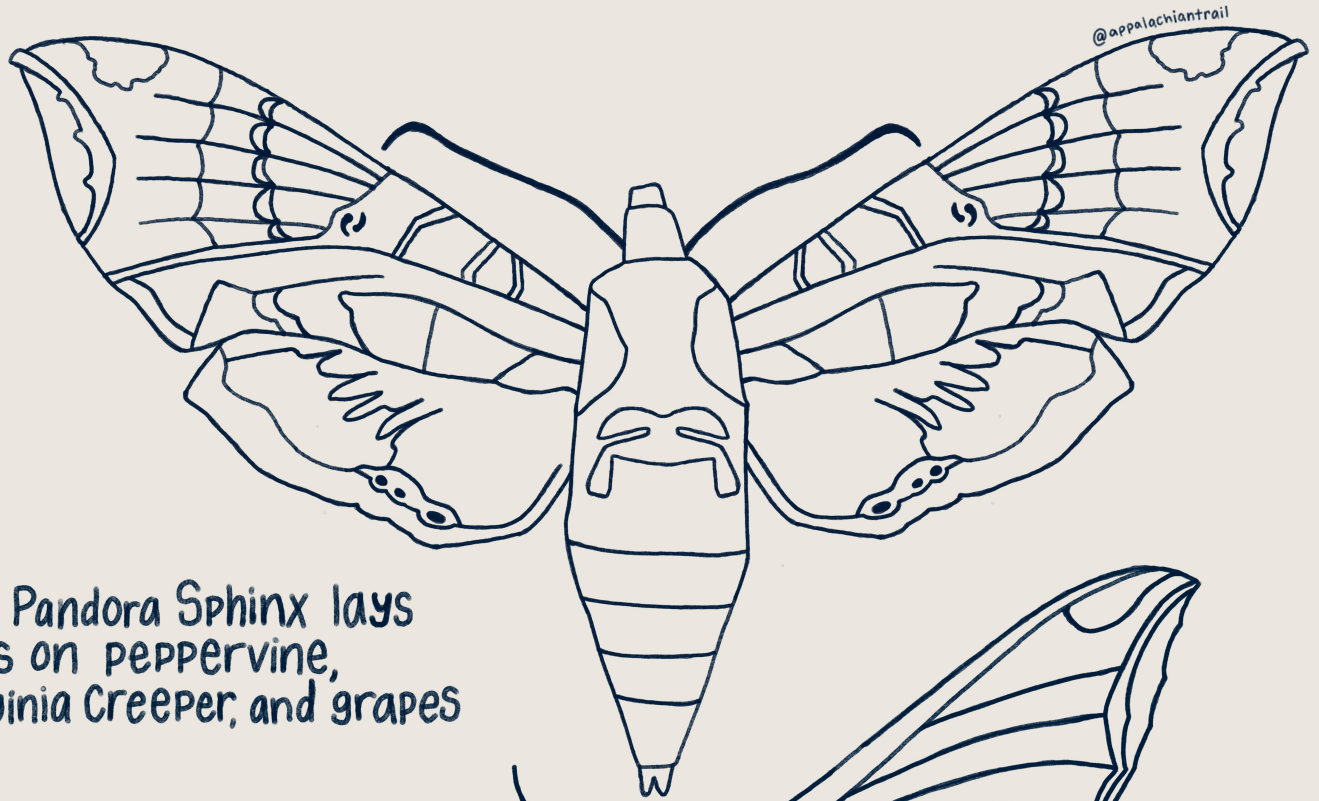




Pandora Sphinx

 The Pandora Sphinx lays eggs on peppervine, Virginia Creeper, and grapes

 These moths drink nectar from white companions, petunias, and bouncing bets

 This moth flies North from June to August and South from April to October

 Females are typically larger than males with wing spans ranging from 8.2 to 11.5 centimeters
