

# Protecting the Trail and Surrounding Landscape

MAINE To restore aquatic connectivity for the endangered Atlantic salmon, the ATC worked with partners to replace a perched culvert with a bridge over Henderson Brook in the 100 Mile Wilderness. The project is helping rescue the species from the brink of extinction.

MASSACHUSETTS A team of ATC staff and volunteers removed invasive species from 8 acres of rare plant habitat near the Shaker shelter campsite, wrapping up the

shelter campsite, wrapping up the final project under a three-year grant from the National Park Service.

VIRGINIA The ATC and key partners announced the creation of the McAfee Vista Preserve, 850 acres of contiguous forested lands covering a significant portion of the McAfee Knob viewshed, regarded as one of the most popular scenic overlooks on the entire 2,198-mile Appalachian Trail.

## Ensuring a World-Class Recreational Experience

**CONNECTICUT** More than 50 staff and volunteers replaced two popular shelters, Brassie Brook and Riga, which had reached the end of their useful life, requiring a combined 795 hours of work.

**NEW YORK** A Mid-Atlantic crew completed an audit of the signs and blazes marking the boundary of the A.T. corridor, the protected lands on either side of the footpath that contribute to the Trail's scenic beauty.

GEORGIA Nearly 3,000 hikers registered the start of their northbound thru-hike, a similar number to last year. More than 90% of thru-hikers are now using the ATC's voluntary hiker registration system to alleviate overcrowding along the Trail.

# Expanding the Community of Trail Stewards

**NEW JERSEY** Some 30 young adults attended the 2023 Emerging Leaders Summit to expand their Trail management skills and cultivate community among the next generation of conservation leaders.

MARYLAND Boonsboro and Brunswick joined the A.T. Community™ program in June—the first two communities Maryland. There are now 56 designated communities in 13 states—serving as gateways to the Trail and partners in environmental conservation.

#### **NORTH CAROLINA** Youth

Conservation Corps members assisted in a trail rehabilitation project on Albert Mountain, stabilizing rock steps on a steep stretch. The ATC's Konnarock Trail Crew and Nantahala Hiking Club volunteers led the project team.
